1. **Report date** – date report sent to STG

2. **Identifier** - who the report is coming from

3. **Highlights** – text copied by STG to produce Scientific and Non-Scientific report

4. **Report contact** – email/ phone/ name for questions related to the report

iPHIS data

- Provincial EARS/CUSUM flags investigated on 4/6 entered into iPHIS as of April 6, did not appear to be related to P/PAG
- No new cases of reportable disease reporting a Pan Am Games exposure were identified in iPHIS as of April 6
- No new reportable disease notifications to report

Laboratory

- Volume of on-Games related specimens are within expected range
- Two new Games related notifications were received at PHOL

- Ontario is not involved in national investigations/outbreaks this time
- Limited flu activity
- No cases of WNV

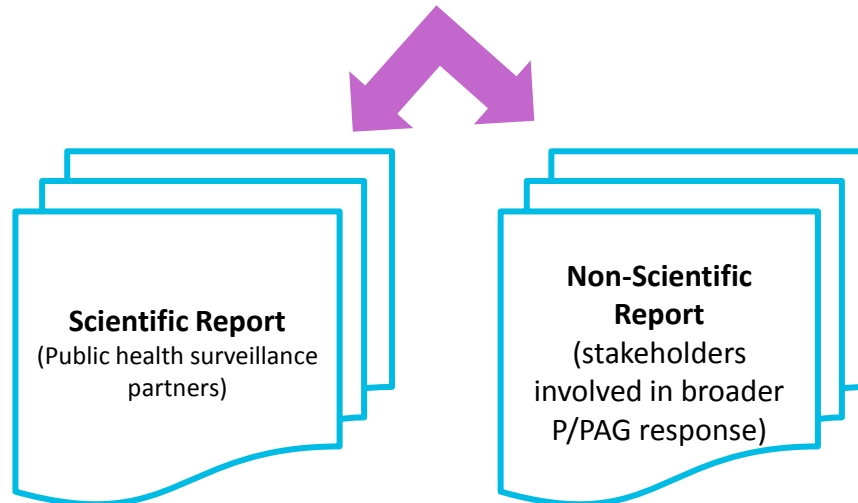

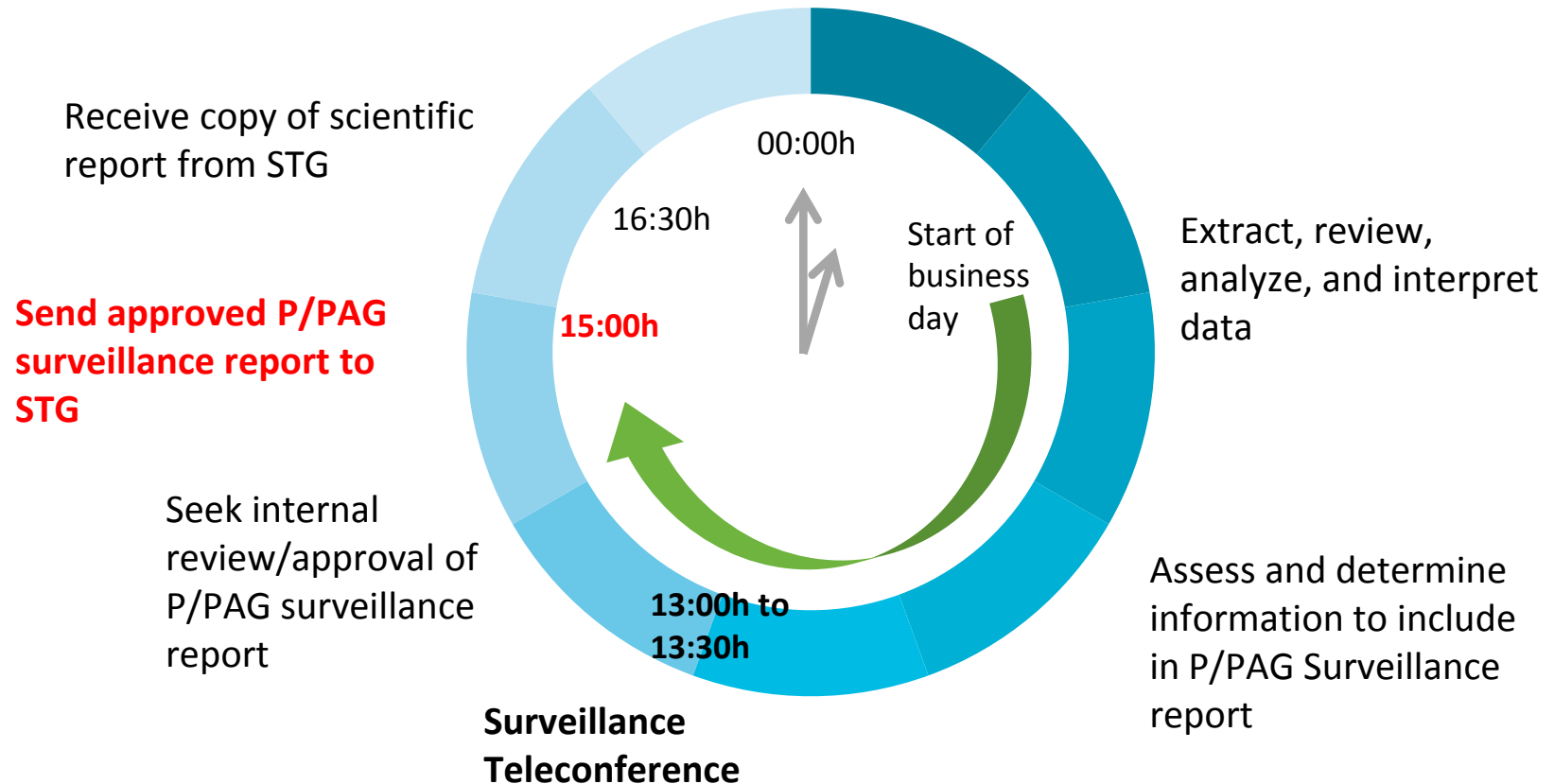

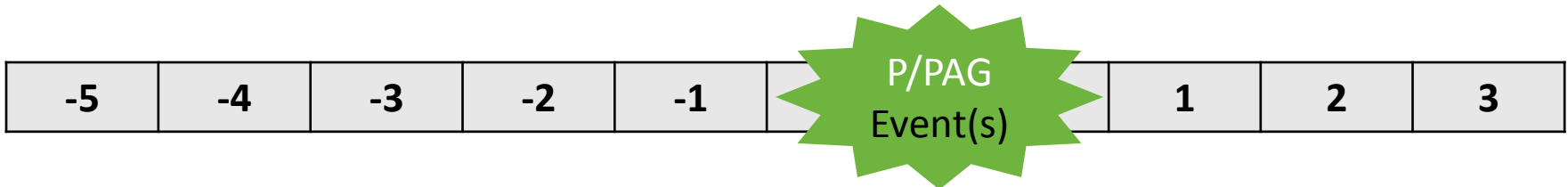
